



The chart and information below outline the legislated requirements to work under the COVID-19 Protection Framework (CPF).

Health Service – Vaccine pass not required	Close contact business – Vaccine pass required

Ventilation

- Change of air flow
 - Open window / door
 - Ventilate between clients
- HEPA filter / air purifier (beware of charlatans)
- More guidance from MOH to follow

Masks

- Surgical recommended
- N95 not required
